ORDER TERMINATING ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST
OTS RESOLUTION NO. DAL-91-112, DATED AUGUST 13, 1991

WHEREAS, the Office of Thrift Supervision (OTS) is authorized by Section 8 of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act, 12 U.S.C. Section 1818, to issue enforcement orders, including orders to cease and desist, where it is of the opinion that grounds exist for the issuance of such orders, and such order remains effective and enforceable as provided therein, except to the extent that it is modified or terminated by action of OTS.

WHEREAS, the Regional Directors of OTS have delegated authority to determine whether to terminate outstanding enforcement orders, such as OTS ORDER NO DAL-91-112, dated August 13, 1991, issued against First Savings Bank, a Federal Savings Bank, Arlington, Texas (First Savings Bank):

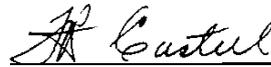
